## Immediately Following Public Hearings Regular Plan Commission Meeting

Present were Chairman Leair and Plan Commission members Engelking, Lightfoot, Turzynski and Toole. Also present was Town Board Supervisor Ross. Also in attendance was Administrator/Planner Herrmann and Deputy Clerk Workman.

- 1. <u>Discussion/Action-on Zoning Amendment Section 19 (A) Accessory Uses and Structures for the Town of Genesee Zoning Code.</u> No discussion or action as public hearing was adjourned until September 25, 2023
- 2. <u>Discussion/Action Site Plan/Plan of Operation for Sally's Sweet Shoppe. The property is described as a part of the SE ½ SW ½ of the NE ½ of Section 21 T6N R18E Town of Genesee Waukesha County. More specifically, the property is located at S42W31238 Hwy 83. (GNT 1521-972-003)</u> Tracey present from Sally's Sweet Shoppe. This is just a move to a different address. Engelking made a motion to approve the Site Plan/Plan of Operation for Sally's Sweet Shoppe subject to the conditions in Planner Herrmann's August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023 memo. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Ross. The motion was approved 6-0
- 3. <u>Discussion/Action- to allow 2 or more accessory buildings for Cynthia Freer. The property is described as being a part of the SW ¼ of Section 8 T6N R18E Town of Genesee, Waukesha County. More specifically, the property is located at W329S3086 Bryn Mawr Rd. (GNT 1471-994)</u>
  Freer present. Planner Herrmann showed the existing three accessory buildings, one of which will be torn down and replaced. Engelking made a motion to approve the three accessory structures. Seconded by Supervisor Ross. The motion was approved 6-0
- 4. <u>Discussion about future Plan of Operation reviews for Shoreland areas in the Town of Genesee</u>
  Planner Herrmann stated that the country wants to know if the Plan Commission wants to review minor changes in site plan/plan of operations for Shoreland zoning. Any new business would still come before the Plan Commission. Engelking states that he does not see that as a problem.
- 5. <u>Discussion/Action -Approval of the August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2023 Plan Commission Meeting Minutes</u> Engelking made a motion to approve the August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2023 Plan Commission Minutes. Seconded by Supervisor Ross. The motion was approved 6-0
- 6. <u>Update on Pending Enforcement Matters</u> Planner Herrmann made aware that Coker was present because he has filed a lawsuit against the town for his Conditional Use. We will not talk about the lawsuit in a public forum. It was decided that the letters presented at the August 28<sup>th</sup> Public Hearing do not pertain to the topic of the August 28<sup>th</sup> Public Hearing, but rather to a previously closed Public Hearing of which no more evidence can be received. Planner Herrmann states that there are a couple of businesses that he has received complaints on that he is going to follow up with.
