This is an Ordinance that the State is asking for, Fedak is asking that we apply directly what is defined in the State code for the campground or camping units to our Ordinance. Toni Basile requested her duplex to be billed for only one garbage bill as she is not using the second side of the duplex. Herrmann said that per our Ordinance we bill for each side of a duplex. The problem is we have no way to monitor if someone starts living in the other side. Discussion. The only way to have it removed is to make the duplex into a single family. Herrmann talked about the possibility of a deed restriction. Herrmann will look into it and get back to Basile.
