

**TOWN OF GENESEE
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING
NOVEMBER 11, 2025
IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE BUDGET HEARING
AND THE MEETING OF THE ELECTORS AT 6:00 p.m.**
