

**TOWN OF GENESEE
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MINUTES
DECEMBER 8, 2025**

Chairman Tesch called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were Chairman Tesch, Town Board Supervisors Ross, Braun and Gresser. Also present were Administrator Herrmann, Public Works Superintendent Gryzkewicz and Clerk-Treasurer Majeskie. Supervisor Morris was absent.

Discussion/Action - Approve the Bills

Ross made a motion to approve the bills, seconded by Braun. The motion passed 4-0.

Report

Update on removal of woody vegetation from the parks

Gryzkewicz said the fire department said if he had a machine at the burning site he should be ok to burn. Because of all the trees we have trimmed and chopped down we have a lot of material to dispose of.

Discussion/Action – New counter tops

Discussion. Ross made the motion to approve installing counter tops not to exceed \$7,500.00 using existing money in the 2025 budget, seconded by Gresser. The motion passed 3-1. Braun voting against.

Chairman – Terry Tesch

Update on ATV-UTV Routes

Chairman Tesch said the signs for the designated routes for ATV-UTV's will be put up soon and the ATV-UTV's will be able to drive on town roads. They still are prohibited from driving on all County and State roads.

Discussion/Action – 911 signs being moved and put on mailboxes

The Board discussed 911 sign being moved onto mailboxes. The Board would like a notice in the newsletter to remind people that the signs are for emergency vehicles to be able to fine their homes quickly in an emergency when minutes can mean the difference between life and death.

Discussion/Action – Resolution 25-8R to Adopt the Charges and Fee Schedule for 2026

Discussion. Ross made a motion to approve Resolution 25-8R, seconded by Braun. The motion passed 4-0.

Discussion/Action – Reduction of letter of Credit for Cardinal Court

Ross made a motion to approve the reduction of the letter of credit Cardinal Court to \$30,714, seconded by Gresser. The motion passed 4-0.

Discussion/Action – Appointment of poll workers for the 2026-2027 Election cycle.

Ross made a motion to approve the 2026-2027 poll worker list, seconded by Braun.
The motion passed 4-0.

Discussion/Action – 11-11-2025 Regular Town Board Minutes

Ross made a motion to approve the 11-11-2025 minutes, seconded by Braun. The motion passed 4-0.

Discussion/Action – Request for Operator license

Closed Session


